Innocence Freed is a faith-based nonprofit organization dedicated to providing healing, support, and restoration to survivors of child and adult sexual exploitation and human trafficking.

To provide trauma-informed care, support, and resources that empower survivors of human trafficking and sexual exploitation to live in freedom, dignity, and hope.

We serve survivors in Nebraska and beyond through both in-person and confidential virtual programming.

## Our Mission

Innocence Freed is a faith-based nonprofit organization dedicated to providing shelter, healing, and hope to survivors of child and adult sexual exploitation and human trafficking. Guided by God's love, we bridge the gap between despair and recovery through comprehensive, trauma-informed programs.

## Our vision

To develop a model of excellence that transforms the lives of adult and child victims of human trafficking. Rooted in faith and compassion, we strive to expand our impact nationwide by providing a haven and comprehensive restorative care, upholding the dignity of every survivor we serve.



## **Our Future**

We are expanding our efforts to support women ages 19+ and girls ages 12–18 who have experienced human trafficking and sexual exploitation. Our goal is to provide evidence-based, long-term, evidence-based, trauma-informed care in a safe and nurturing living environment, where each survivor is met with compassion, dignity, and understanding.

## **What We Do**

### **Trauma-Informed Aftercare Services**

- Survivor support groups
- One-on-one mentorship
- Case management and advocacy
- Life skills and financial coaching
- Equine-assisted learning and therapy
- Mental health therapy and support
- Equipping communities through training, speaking, and education, partnering with businesses, schools, colleges, law enforcement, hospitals, and clinics to raise awareness and prevent exploitation.
- Assist with legislative efforts fighting human trafficking

### **Stability Grants**

We provide direct financial assistance to child and adult survivors for urgent needs such as:

- Rent and utilities
- Transportation and vehicle repairs
- Food and essentials
- Education and employment support
- Mental health

- Identity and healing through Christ
- Survivor-led encouragement and community

### **Our Impact**

#### **2026 (Jan 1, 2026 to May 1, 2026):**

- 339+ hours of direct survivor care and support
- Weekly survivor support groups
- Ongoing mentorship through calls, texts, and meetings
- Aftercare needs have doubled since 2025
- New survivors are actively being served and supported every week

#### **2025 Highlights:**

- 56 survivors served
- 2,720 volunteer hours
- Stability grants distributed for critical needs
- Expanded partnerships and community outreach

Survivors of trafficking often face overwhelming barriers, including trauma, instability, lack of resources, and isolation.
